The Director will recruit and lead a team of volunteers to enrich the lives of children by achieving the mission of Mt. Pisgah Baptist Church - **loving, growing, serving, and going**.

- Demonstrate reliability, initiative, and self-motivation in carrying out ministry responsibilities
- Effectively manage tasks and priorities to complete responsibilities in a timely and efficient manner
- Basic computer skills with the ability to learn new technology for ministry purposes

- Maintain a consistent Christian lifestyle in personal habits including abstention from drugs, alcohol, and tobacco

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide vision, strategy, and development for all children birth through kindergarten
- Provide leadership, direction, training, and oversight for all Preschool Ministry volunteers serving with children birth through kindergarten
- Develop and implement all Preschool Ministry programming - including, but not limited to: Sunday mornings, Sunday evenings and Wednesday evenings
- Develop and oversee systems and processes for check-in, classroom placement, and dismissal, ensuring proper age grouping, safe transitions, and adherence to approved child-to-volunteer ratios
- Collaborate with the Children's Ministry Director and Event Director to plan, coordinate, and maintain registration for events - including, but not limited to: Eggspllosion, Summer Camps, Vacation Bible School, and Fall Festival
- Work with the Discipleship Pastor to regularly review and evaluate all Preschool Ministry curriculum
- Ensure the safety and protection of children through policies, procedures, background checks, and child protection training
- Maintain a safe, clean, and aesthetic environment
- Develop a strategy for reaching and assimilating new children and families
- Partner with families to support their children's spiritual and developmental growth
- Develop, submit, and monitor the Preschool Ministry budget

- Support the mission and vision of Mt. Pisgah by executing the responsibilities of the Preschool Ministry Director role and supporting other ministry areas as needed.
